I received a question about what this "Red Letter Day" is all about.

Not many people know this day or never heard about it.

There are so many stories about Red Letter day but Passover is the most extraordinary story. Passing over from death to Eternal life.

If we see what Yeshua has endured, it all reflects back on his past months of His ministry on earth. A time set apart to give as a reflection of what our life should be like

During the time Yeshua started preparing for the Kingdom He made sure He fully completed the commandments of His Father.

When He completed it and showed us it is "possible" to walk in YHVH's ways He restored the eternal life for us and "It was done!"

Throughout the ministry of Yeshua, He spend substantial amounts of time to come kneeling in prayer before His Father modeling the obedience of solitude.

We too need essential spiritual time every day to meditate on our Adonai's word. This is a time we set as a Moadim to set it apart from any other day having an Appointment to enjoy spiritual connection with our Creator to strengthen our relationship with Him.

This spiritual time of connection helps us to cultivate an inner solitude and silence that sets us free from fear, Lonelines or inner emptiness. It fills our inner fulfillment knowing He is fully in control of all circumstances of our life. YHVH is in the middle of our daily mission leading the way He wants us to walk.

The Red day was a celebration that we have entery through prayer and through Yeshua we no longer have to face death but have eternal life.

Later the red letter turned to play a role of condemning people. If you received a letter from your boss written in red you were fired.

But we know that even if this was established that no man on earth can say it is finish until YHVH says so. YHVH moves us in new directions to complete His plans for us. The red blood of the Lamb was used on the doorpost of the Israelites to prevent any evil harm to enter in.

The entire plan was that YHVH already planned the way to the Promised Land for those who will Hear His voice and follow Him.

YHVH showed His presence in a pillar of a cloud and all the Israelites had to do was pray and He will respond to them.

The Red Letter day reminds us of the letters written on the cross. That Yeshua victorious escaped death into eternal life and He is the King of the Jews.
