## *The Lilies of The Valley*

### **Overcome the Darkness**

The paralyzing darkness fell on Egypt, while Pharaoh hardened his heart and refused the Israelites to go. With every plague that were directly aimed at the false gods served in Egypt, YHVH made Him known as God who is Almighty.

Many in the world will one day experience a great, devastating darkness, which is one of the end-time plagues prophesied in the Book of Revelation.

As Pharaoh refused to acknowledge the power of YHVH and continued to measure up, we also find in the book of Revelations a similar situation.

Revelation tells us that even when the angel pours out the fifth bowl of YHVH's wrath, the kingdom of the beast will be plunged into total darkness.

This will not convince the servants of Satan to repent and turn to the Maker of All.

## Revelation 16:10–11

*Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. They blasphemed the YHVH of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.”*

The foreshadowing of **Sheol (hell)**, is a complete absence of all light and many people will descend into it.

YHVH prewarned His actions that will come. Every prophecy is in place to prepare, return and remain in the light, however before the second coming of Yeshua HaMashiach, the Bible is clear there will be a “falling away” (2 Thessalonians 2:3).

There will be a “revival and transformation” time before the return of our Messiah. Matthew 24:14. “And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.”

YHVH gave us sufficient time to change our ways and turn away from Paganism and serving false Feasts or even accepting the Mark of the Beast. We as the righteous people of YHVH are already saved by His Grace and by the only blood of Yeshua HaMashiach that takes away the sins of the world.

Denying Yeshua HaMashiach or his blood sacrificed is like being an Antichrist.

Before these plagues came about to the Egyptians, the decree went out to kill the the new born. YHVH called the Israelites His firstborn.

We as the children of YHVH are Kingdom material and we are His Firstborn. The Antichrists mission is to kill the firstborn once again to reduce the numbers.

YHVH therefore in the tenth Plague strikes the Firstborn (Macat B'Chorot מַכַּת בְּכוֹרוֹת)

### **Romans 12:19**

*Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of YHVH, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says YHVH."*

As YHVH showed up several times in the Scriptures to save His beloved, YHVH in His presence stood by the Israelites to ensure their Salvation. So also in our time YHVH will take vengeance.

As YHVH Promised to Abraham that his seed (firstborn) descendants will as numerous as the stars in the sky and will give them all these lands, and through his offspring all nations on earth will be blessed,

YHVH will lead His children in the biggest Exodus that can ever be imagined. The ordinary will not exceed the extraordinary. Reminding ourselves "YHVH is Supernatural"

## Exodus 11:4–6

*“This is what YHVH says: ‘About midnight I will go throughout Egypt. Every firstborn in Egypt will die, from the firstborn son of Pharaoh, who sits on the throne, to the firstborn of the slave girl, who is at her hand mill, and all the firstborn of the cattle as well. There will be loud wailing throughout Egypt—worse than there has ever been or ever will be again.’”*

When Pharaoh still refused to repent and relent after the Plague of Darkness, YHVH sent the tenth and most devastating plague the Striking of the Firstborn of Egypt.

YHVH acts on behalf of His people and judgment will fall on the enemies of Israel.

Pharaoh, Egypt’s king refused to let YHVH's firstborn (Israel) go, so YHVH took Pharaoh's firstborn and those of his loyal servants. YHVH stated those who curse Israel will be cursed, He will treat the nations (and individuals) as they have treated the Firstborn Israel, the children of YHVH.

So much have been pointing us in the direction of prophecy after prophesy and we have seen these things falling into to place as predicted. As the people are persecuted for the righteous sake of their Faith and believe, YHVH is keeping guard of all His beloved.

Pharaoh was in a state of pride, being unmoved, remaining stubborn and not giving up on selfsuffiecient power.

While his selfish choices and act done more harm than good, the stubbornness caused suffering, when YHVH even went as far to struck down Egypt's firstborn. Only when Pharaoh's own son died, then the hardness of his heart was broken through.

The evil and darkness inside the heart of Pharaoh proven that he was blinded to the pain suffered by others until he felt the pain himself.

How tragic that it took the death of Pharaoh's own child to bring him to the place of humility and submission where he was willing to let YHVH's people go.

As we all experience a lockdown, privileges removed from us, many being forced to partake in the Mark of the Beast, we will be released from the bondages of the Antichrist when revealed to all the nations.

YHVH ordered the Israelites to guard themselves by the blood of the Lamb on their doorpost. Moses prepared the people of Israel for this final judgment on Egypt by instructing them to sacrifice a lamb and to put its blood on the tops and sides of their doors.

### **Exodus 12:7**

*“And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.”*

The blood of the Passover lamb served as the sign that caused the judgment to “pass over” the Israelites, sparing them from suffering the wrath of YHVH that fell upon the Egyptians.

The magicians of Pharaoh became powerless and could not perform or match these last three plagues. The power of the blood of Yeshua HaMashiach is still at work.

### **Exodus 12:13**

*“Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.”*

Moses lead the children of Israel out of Egypt, and YHVH gave them the ordinances of the Passover.

YHVH said several times "Fear not, for I Am with you".

### **Hebrews 13:6**

*So we say with confidence, “YHVH is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?”*

Thus YHVH did all He had promised; not one Word that YHVH had spoken was left unfulfilled. Reminding ourselves of this truth helps us to also trust in YHVH’s faithfulness, power, and mercy now and in the days to come.

We have the Scriptures filled with the Assurance of YHVH.

Some verses that we can hold unto in these times.

### **Nehemiah 8:10**

*Do not grieve, for the joy of YHVH is your strength.*

### **Isaiah 41:10**

*So do not fear, for I Am with you; do not be dismayed, for I Am your Elohim. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.*

### **Exodus 15:2**

YHVH is my strength and my song; he has given me victory.
